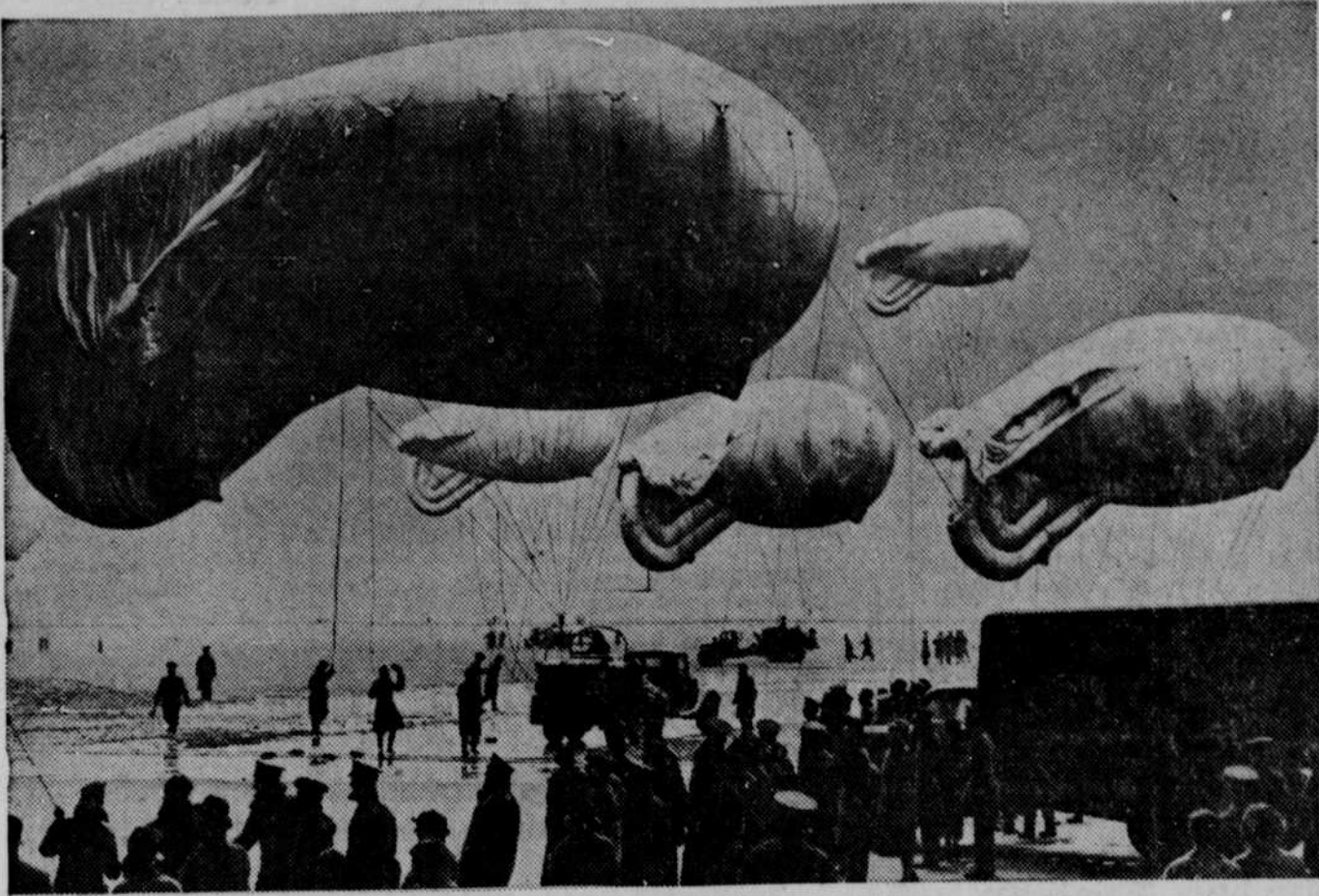


Balloons to Protect London From Airplanes

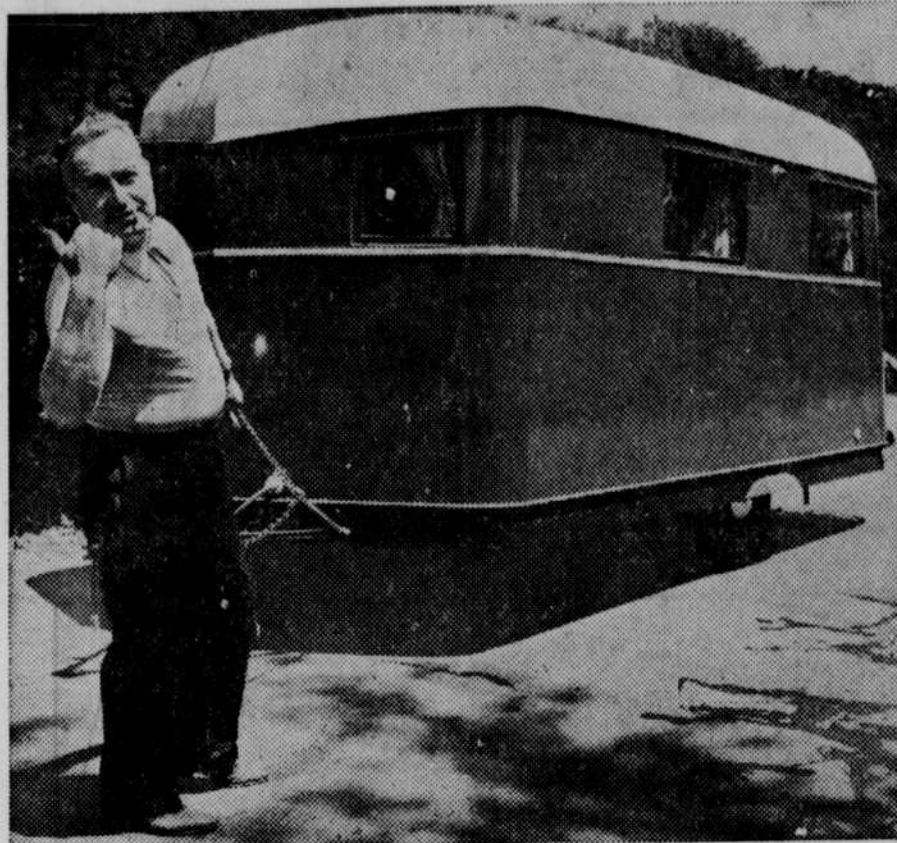

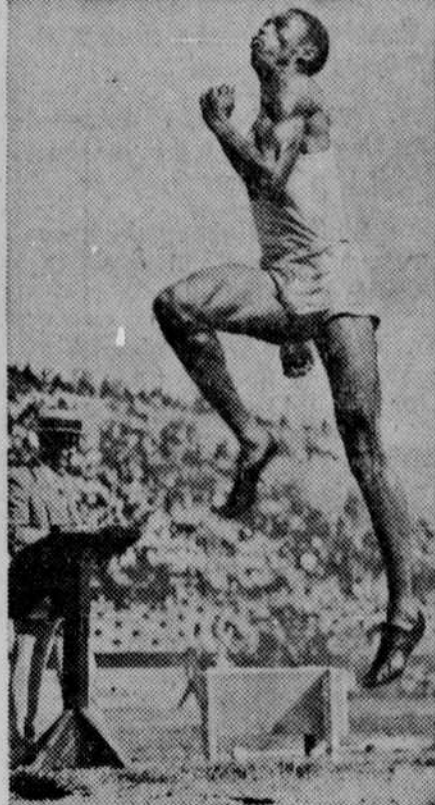

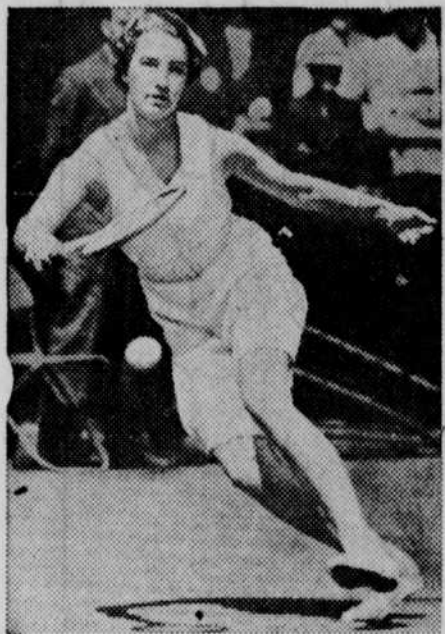
KISS FOR AN ENSIGN

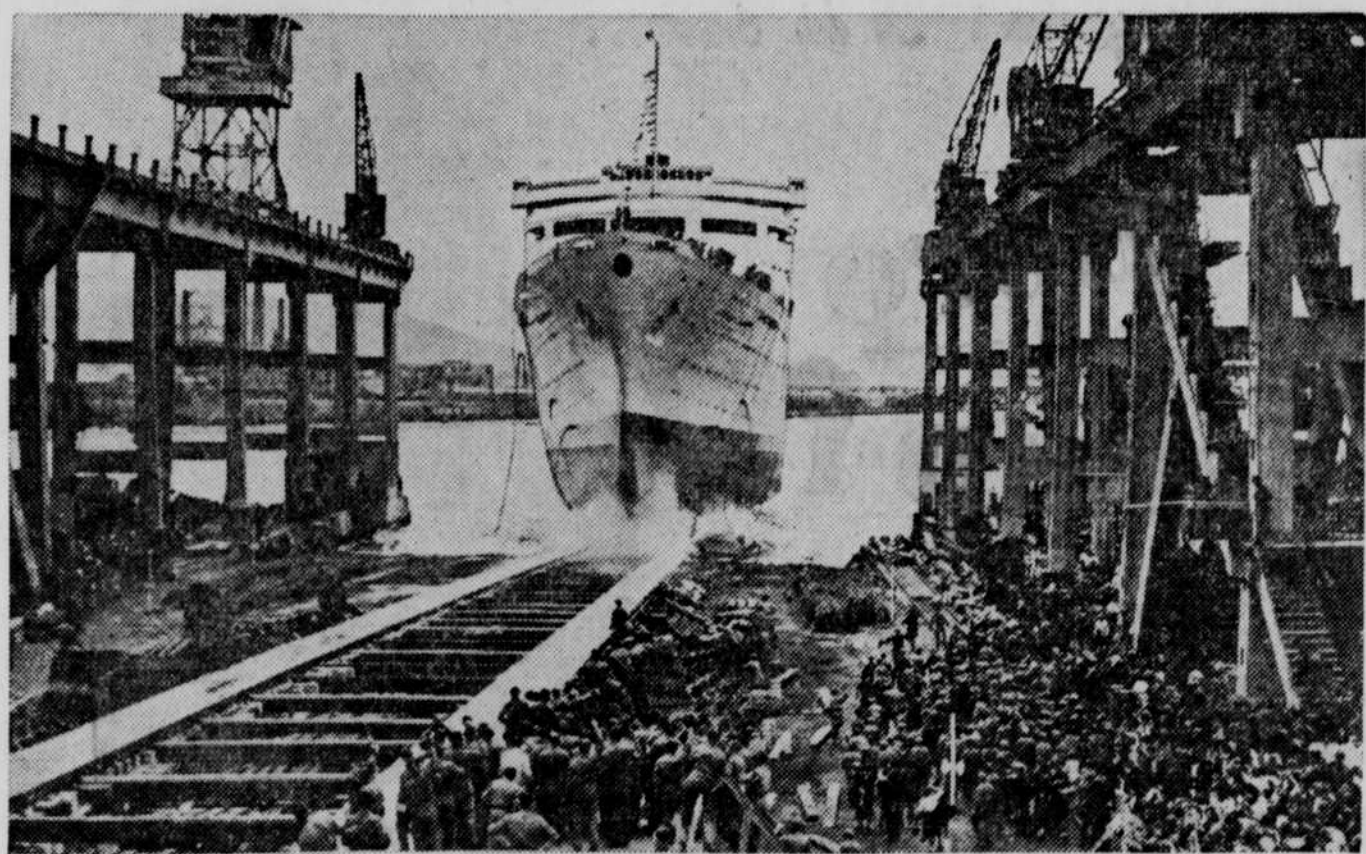
