

Bowlers Prepare for Nation-Wide Tournament



Typical of 30,000 War Veteran Families





French Army Rushes Tunisian Fortifications





Should it fall into Italy's hands, the Mediterranean could be closed easily to French and British communications. Fully aware of these strategical considerations, France has been openly rushing Tunisian fortifications. On the Mareth line, near the Libyan border, France has stationed 35,000 soldiers-Zouaves and the Foreign Legion. Italian troops in Libya are reported at 60,000.
