# 115,000 **VOLT LINE** READY BY FALL

Consumers Asks Bids on Equipment for Norfolk-Neligh-O'Neill Area

With the new 115 thousand volt transmission line being constructed by Consumers Public Power district in the Norfolk-Neligh-O'Neill area progressing rapidly, Consumers has advertised for bids on substations, control and relay equipment, switchgear and other re-lated equipment to be installed in conjunction with the new

According to Consumers officials, the new line is expected to be completed some time this Fall and will be operated at 33 thousand volts temporarily until substation equipment and other facilities can be completed at Norfolk and O'Neill for opera-tion at 115 thousand volts.

The advertisement for bids covered one 69 thousand volt substation for O'Neill, one 115 thousand, and one 34,500 volt substation for Neligh and one 34,500 volt substation for Norfolk, along with control and relay equipment, outside switch gear, lightning arresters, trans-formers and other equipment for the various locations necessary for completion of Consumers portion of the construction to tie in with the high voltage tranmission grid of the 8tf Nebraska public power system.
The Nebraska public power system will install that portion service and genuine parts of the substation equipment call at Vic Halva's Electric related to the delivery of power to the substations connecting the new line.

The new 115 thousand volt line will connect with the Nebraska public power system grid at Norfolk and will transmit additional power to towns served by Consumers Public Power district in the Norfolk-Neligh-O'Neill areas and West.

It will provide an additional power source for this area as Spencer Monday, June 28, to soon as connected for operation
