On that day the Althing-an 11-centuries-old legislative body sometimes called the "Grandmother of Parliaments"elected the nation's former regent. Sveinn Bjornsson, president. 

Closer bonds between the United States and its African protege Liberia were assured by the December, 1943, treaty, the provisions of which were made public on October 30, 1944. The treaty stipulates that all naval, military and air installations will be supervised by the U.S. Significant changes took place in 1944 in the New world. Argentina abolished all political parties and instituted strict censorship of the press. The tiny Atlantic island of Bermuda modernized some of its




