

# West O'Neill, Bristow Cop with Big Scores

## BUTTE CLIMBS INTO LEAGUE LEAD BY BLASTING CHAMBERS 3 - 2

High scores featured Sunday's round of games in the newly-organized Holt-Boyd county league and West O'Neill downed Bristow 10-9 and Stuart spanked Atkinson 10-7. The O'Neill Rockets couldn't qualify for high-scoring, however, as Lynch administered a 5-1 defeat, and Butte bested Chambers 3-2 in a thriller.

By virtue of Butte's slim win over Chambers and a reversal handed Atkinson, Butte takes an undisputed lead in the loop—the first time this season the number one position has not been shared. (See the league standings in column 1.)
