TRICKS of MAGIC EXPLAINED by Will L. Lindhorst

THE MAGIC LUMP OF SUGAR



Select a person in your audience and with a soft pencil mark his initial on a lump of sugar. Secretly press your thumb against the lump over the initial so that an impression of the initial appears on your thumb. Drop the lump in a glass half filled with water, hold the person's hand palm downward above the glass and press your thumb on which the initial appears, into the palm lightly. Then inform the person that the initial will disappear from the sugar and appear on the palm of his hand. He continues holding his hand above the glass and as the water dissolves the sugar the initial slowly fades away.
