
A small bit of sugar, half a teaspoonful or less added to vegetables while cooking will improve the flavor, also it improves soups, roasts are given a more appetizing brown.

A pinch of salt improves almost any food, custard, applesauce, and other stewed fruits. Add a few grains of salt to cocoa, coffee and chocolate for cake filling, to fudge and to icing as well as all forms of candy. When butter is not used more salt will be needed. Adding salt to cooked fruits will save on sugar, for salt brings out sweetness.
