PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the people of Holt county, State of Nebraska, that a special election has been duly called by the Board of County Supervisors of said County and will be held in said County on the 12th day of November, 1935, at which election the following proposition will be submitted to a vote of the people of said County:

"Shall the County of Holt, State of Nebraska, issue its bonds of the principal amount of Sixty-one Thousand Dollars (\$61,000.00) for the purpose of erecting a suitable Court House and Jail for said County, said bonds to be dated the first day of December, 1935, and become due in not more than twenty years from their date and bear interest at not exceeding the rate of Four per centum (4%) per annum, said interest to be payable December 1, 1936, and semi-annually thereafter; and shall a tax be levied annually on all the taxable property in said County in addition to all other taxes sufficient in amount to

pay the interest on and the principal of said bonds and when such interest and principal becomes due?"

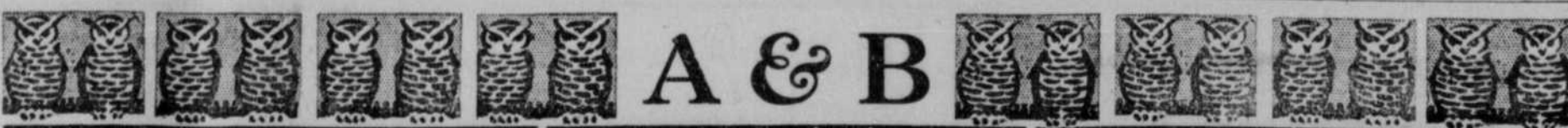
