


### Fifth "Philadelphia" Is Launched for U. S. Navy


### Tarpon Swim Suits New Florida Vogue

### Franklin D., Jr., Engaged to Be Married







### MEMORIAL OF BATTLE





### Peggy Joyce and Husband-to-Be





### Golf Champs Try Out Florida Turf




