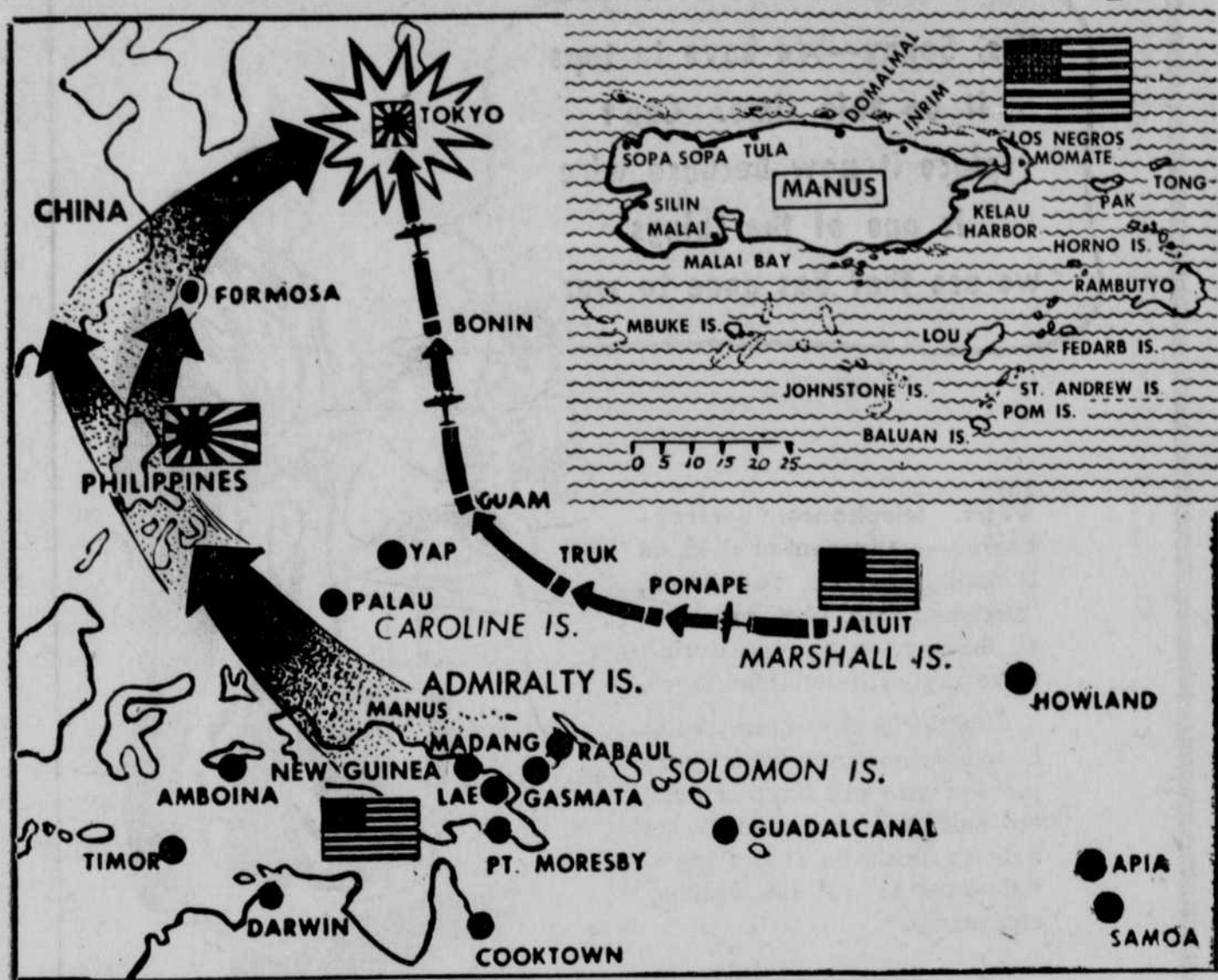


## Two Roads That Lead Direct to Heart of Japan

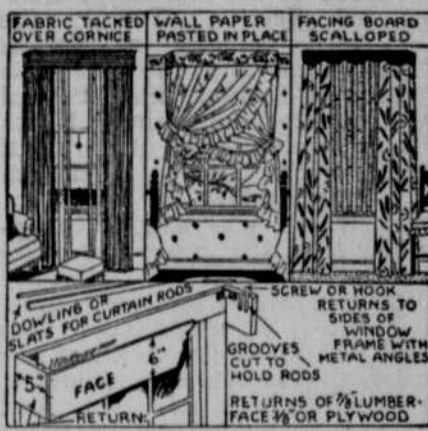

## Three Ways to Use Wooden Cornices

ELABORATE box-like cornices to cover all rods and fixtures used in hanging curtains were the height of fashion in the formal rooms of the mid-Victorian period. Cornices are still used in simplified forms for our own windows.

This sketch shows three different treatments of box cornices for modern windows. They all give a professional effect, yet any amateur must make them. The diagram shows grooves cut on the inside of the returns to hold wooden rods or slat to be used instead of metal rods for hanging glass curtains and overdraperies.



If you already have double curtain rods, just leave them in place and fit your cornice over them. If you decide to paint the wood instead of covering it, the color may match the room woodwork or it may repeat some color in the drapery material, as shown at the right.

NOTE: This is the fourth and last of the series on modern adaptations of period curtain styles. If you are interested in making scalloped wooden cornices you will want pattern 207 which contains designs of scallops which may be used to cut dozens of different types to fit windows of any size. 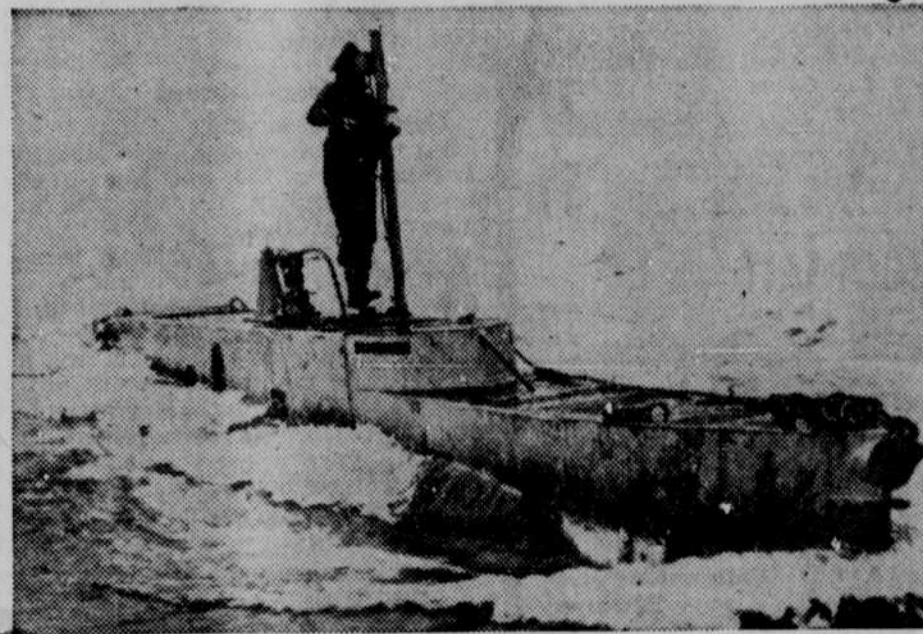
