CAN WE RAISE OUR OWN FISH?

An Experiment, and its Prospects.

Letters from Senator Paddock and Committee on Baird.

In the eastern states, although the waters of the sea yield an abundance of fish, yet by a well systematized plan, new kinds of fish have been introduced and propagated in the numerous lakes and rivers which seclude among the hills, or meander through the valleys.

One of our townsmen, Mr. Kaley, has taken the matter in hand and already has a pond, L shaped, and covering at present about an acre, in which he intends to put fish eggs and try the experiment of raising fish.

He intends to make further improvements in the spring. He applied too late for eggs this fall as will be seen by the following correspondence.
