- Resolved, That the voting of said bonds would insure the building of said railroad from Hastings to Red Cloud, and would largely increase the population, material resources and general prosperity of the several precincts through which said railroad would run, and would considerably enhance the value of real estate in all of said precincts.
- Resolved, That a failure to vote said bonds would insure the building of said railroad from some other point in said county to Red Cloud, and would materially retard the growth and future prosperity of the city of Hastings, and permanently injure the citizens of the eastern part of said county.
- Resolved, That it is expedient and for the best interests of the people of Denver, Little Blue and Pawnee precincts to vote said bonds, and use their influence to secure the building of said railroad from the city of Hastings.
