On the 15th of April Grand Island voted on the proposition to issue city bonds to the amount of \$2,500 for water works to be used in case of fire.

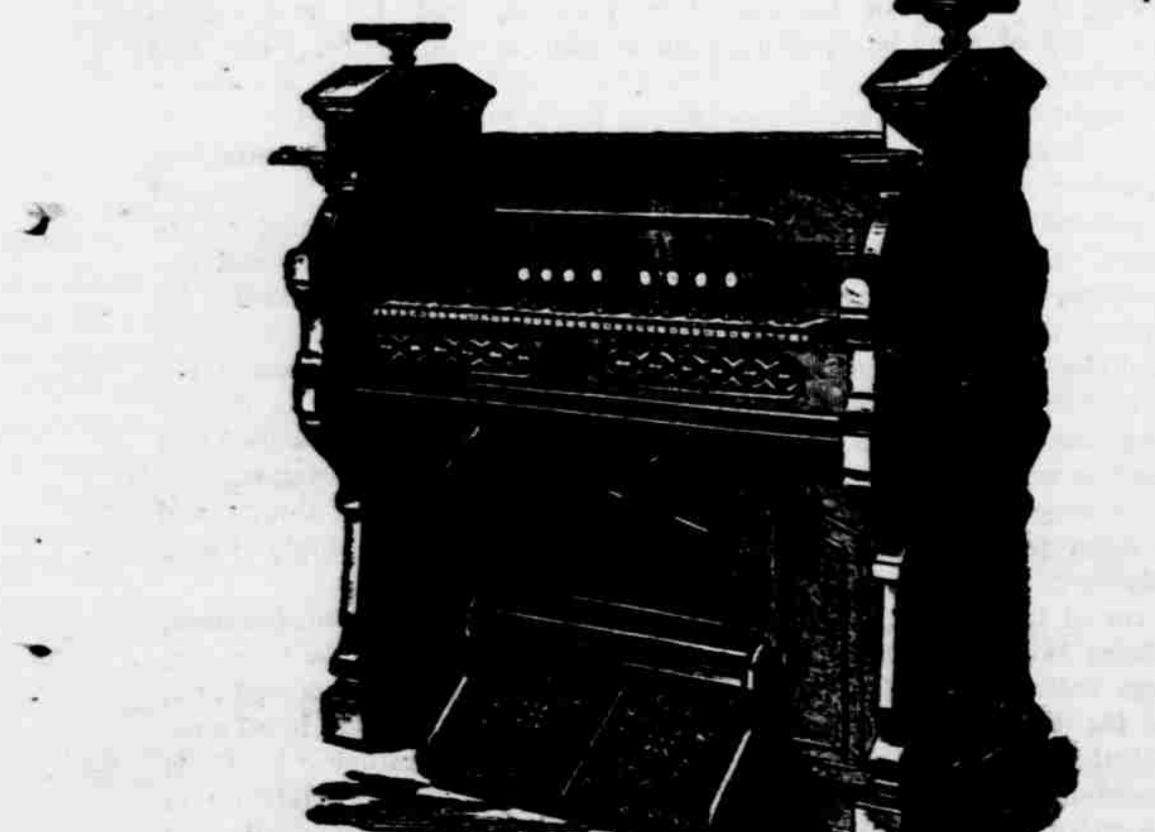
Mr. Henry Fisher, a resident of section 24, town 7, range 1, Taylor county, has discovered a twelve inch vein of coal eight feet from the surface.
