FIFTY out of the fifty-six delegates elected to the New York State Convention are said for Grant, first, last and all the time.

The Plattsmouth Herald calls loudly for what it terms "Marine Hospital Senator Paddock" and says that there is a sick sailor at one of the restaurants, and wants the Hospital "new coat."

The Chicago Times, of the 14th, devotes seven columns to a carefully written and very full statement of the adventures of Nebraska for the production of food of all kinds, and the attractions of its rolling prairies for cultivators of the grain soils of New England, or of the microcosmic farms in Europe.

From present appearances, one is safe in the prediction that the senatorial fight is fairly under way; and that the chances of Mr. Paddock for a re-election are growing exceedingly thinner as time rolls along.

Does Advertising Pay?—The Chicago Tribune, for a column a year receives \$26,000. New York Herald receives, for its lowest price column, \$39,723, and for its highest \$248,000.

A herd of forty elk were seen last week in Well canyon, Lincoln county. Four large two-story brick buildings are to be erected in Crete this spring.

Three pile drivers are being worked on the R. V. R. R. east of Arapahoe putting in bridges. A Colfax county farmer invested \$120 in sheep four years ago and has since cleared \$743.50.

The Nebraska City News states that the indications for a good fruit crop in that vicinity are very promising. A new town christened Dexter has been surveyed near Arapahoe, and has good prospects for settlers.

On an average one convict per day has left the penitentiary this month, their terms of imprisonment having expired. The assurance is given that a \$2,500 fountain will be set up in the government square, Lincoln, during the coming season.

The safe of C. C. McNish, postmaster at winner, was broken open and robbed on the 7th of \$640 in cash, and ten money orders. There are strong indications of fine coal deposits in Knox county, near Niobrara, and a company will speedily be organized to prospect.

Settlements have been made with those injured by the caving in of the embankment of the B. & M. R. R. bridge at Plattsmouth in December. The B. & M. R. R. will erect a \$10,000 brick road house in Lincoln to accommodate twelve large locomotives.
