County Commissioners' Proceedings.

Red Cloud, Neb., August 7, 1884.

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

J. E. Smith, J. L. Miller, John McCullum, county commissioners.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

The resignation of Daniel Snyder O H R D No. 12 was presented and no report of his doings accompanying it. It is hereby ordered by the board of county commissioners that said Daniel Snyder O H R D No. 12 make a report of his services before any action can be taken thereon.

The road petition of J. Russell Giffitt, et al. of Batin precinct was taken up for consideration, and in consequence of other business it was found necessary to fix a day for the hearing of said cause. Board of commissioners fixed the time of hearing for August 14, 1884.

The road petition of R. H. Quiggle and A. M. King et al. Oak Creek, precinct was taken up for consideration, and in consequence of other business the hearing was postponed until August 14, 1884.

The druggist report of F. J. Potter, Wells, Neb., up to June 16, 1884, was presented and filed.

It appearing from the report of county superintendent public instruction that the payment provided by law for defraying expenses of the county institute is unnecessary there being sufficient funds on hand to defray expenses, therefore no appropriation is made for that purpose.
