Clean Silk and Satin.

To clean silk or satin dresses well to take out the dyes and stains, soak the skirt from the bodice or waist down. Have two earthenware vessels each well hold about two gallons each and put half a gallon of champagne in each.

SOAK the bodice in the first pan and when wetted lay it on the champagne board wrong side up. With one hand, according to the direction of the grain, then turn and clean the outside, and as possible. Plunge it again in the first pan. Take it up and allow it to liquor to run off.
