There is most all kinds of land here in a radius of a few miles, red, yellow, and black land and clay foundation and there is sandy land. There is plenty of timber of nearly all kinds, and fruit such as apples, peaches, pears and cherries and therries, such as blackberries, raspberries, strawberries, gooneberries, and buckleberries. We can raise cotton, wheat, onto, rye sugar cane, and Irish pota Clocks, nickel, toes and all kinds of garden vegetables that will grow any where will grow Clocks, alarm here and land is cheap, ranging from five to fifty dollats per acre. Privileges are very good Taxes are low here, not quite one per cent, and we are exempt one bundred and fifty dollars worth of house and kitchen furniture, one voke of oxen. wagon and twenty shoats, and bread stuffs enough to last six months. I have no desire to come back to Webster county to live and pay eight per cent. taxes. Now if this don't find place in the waste basket Nickel Watches. you may hear from this part again. JOHN C. 


