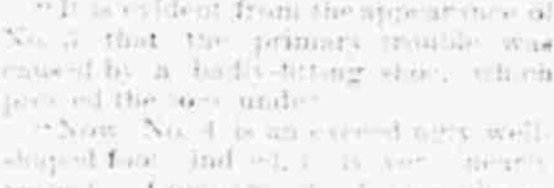

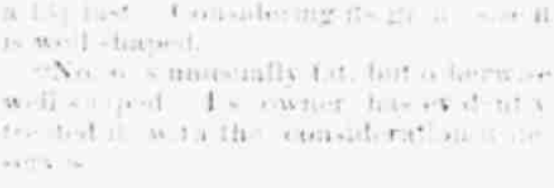
Look at No. 1. The trouble with the foot was caused in great part, if not entirely, by a short shoe...



The peculiar, almost deformity, of No. 2 is in all probability caused by a foot-shaped shoe...



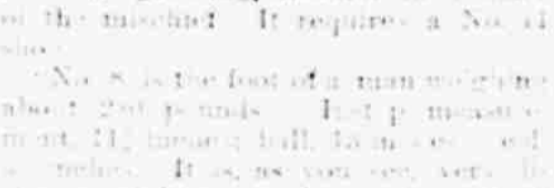
It is evident from the appearance of No. 3 that the primary trouble was caused by a badly-fitted shoe...



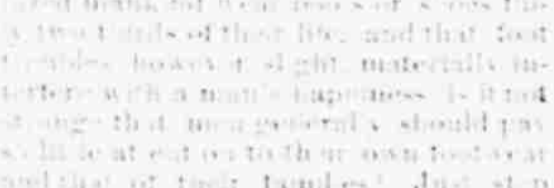
No. 4 is an excellent example of a well-shaped foot. It is very narrow...



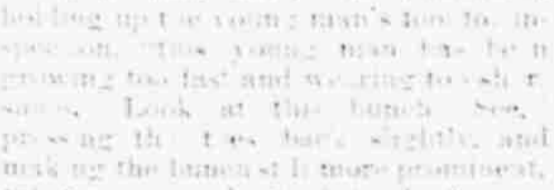

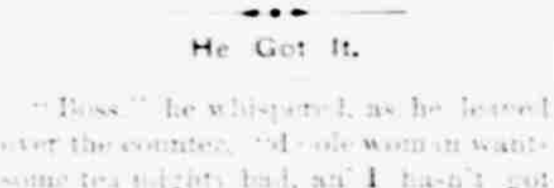
The foot from the right of No. 6 is a very good example of a well-shaped foot...



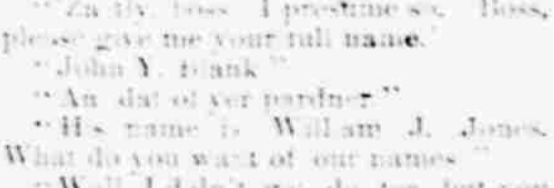
