**AN ORDINANCE**  
To declare certain acts to be a nuisance, and to provide suitable penalties for its violation.

By the ordinance, By the chairman and board of trustees of the village of Red Cloud.  
Sec. 1.—That it is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to keep and hogs, cattle, or other stock in any pen or pens within the corporate village of Red Cloud, in such a manner as to create noxious smells or exhalations, or suffer any filth or putrid matter to accumulate about their premises or in the alleys to the annoyance of any person or persons whomsoever.

Sec. 2.—It is hereby made the duty of the chairman of the board of trustees, upon complaint being made to him that any person or persons are violating the provisions of section one of this ordinance to view the premises complained of, and if in his judgment the matter complained of is a nuisance he shall notify in writing the person or persons so complained of to abate said nuisance.  
Sec. 3.—Any person or persons who shall fail to remove or abate the hogs, cattle or other stock, pen or pens, putrid matter or filth, so declared to be a nuisance, within three days after receiving the notice provided for in section 2 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of committing a nuisance and upon conviction therefor shall pay a fine of not less than one or more than \$20 dollars and costs, and stand committed until the fine and costs are paid.  
Sec. 4.—This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its adoption and publication as provided by law.
