Under no republican rule county funds have been squandered contrary to law until with a tax as high as possible, the county cannot buy bread for its poor. The average Republican however, is so wedded to party that he will probably go to the polls and worse matters again this fall by voting for everything the ring puts on the ticket—*Helmet*.

The above item is absolutely false as relates to the poor of the county. No county in the state takes better care of its poor than does Webster county and as far as the funds of the county having been willfully squandered, it is simply nonsense. The county commissioners have been accused of everything else but squandering money *contra* to law, or *by law*. On the other hand the county finances are in splendid shape for a comparatively new county, and within the next two years the county warrants will be worth their face value anywhere—something that many of the older and wealthier counties of the cultured east can not boast of. The republican officials have honestly conducted the affairs of the county to the satisfaction of their constituency in Webster county.

If the money illegally spent by our county commissioners for a bridge election was converted into a poor fund, the poor of the county might get an occasional loaf of bread.—*Helmet*.

One year ago, or thereabouts the county commissioners asked the people of Webster county to issue bonds for the purpose of erecting proper buildings on the county farm in which to provide for all indigent persons of the county (which practically is worthless without such building,) which the voters, irrespective of party refused to do, and the bonds were defeated, since which time, we believe, the records of the county will show that the commissioners have allowed and issued warrants on the poor fund to an amount greatly in excess of the amount asked for, by the commissioners. If the facts exist that the commissioners did illegally spend money in calling the county bond election of the present year, the wrong could not be righted by the commission of another wrong, viz., the transfer of the money from the bridge fund to the poor fund, as suggested by the *Helmet*. As to the county not taking care of the poor, we think the records will show that they have been very liberal in that direction.

PAYING COUNTY DEBTS WITH WARRANTS is what republican rule has done for this wealthy, high-taxed county.—*Helmet*

The law of Nebraska compels the county commissioners to issue warrants to the amount of 75 per cent. of the levy, for all claims against the county until the levy is exhausted, after which they are compelled to stop issuing warrants, and such warrants are paid in cash on presentation to the county treasurer, provided there are sufficient funds in the treasury. If there are no such funds the warrants draw 7 per cent. interest from the time they are presented for payment until paid. This law has been closely followed by the commissioners, and the remarks of our democratic contemporary are altogether premature and out of place at this time. The county commissioners, as public officers, should transact the business for the county without fear or favor of anyone, which we believe they have tried to do.
