FROM ARKANSAW

Red Cloud, Ark., May 15, 1886.
FRIEND HOSMER: Again with pen in hand I shall attempt to let you know how Arkansas "wags" once a month. We have just finished planting all our crop to-day—that is we finished planting the beans and peas today, but finished planting our broom corn on the 8th of May. Our first planting was put in the 19th of April, and is now up and growing fine. It is our intention to get our broom corn out of the ground before the middle of July, which will be about the middle of August. We have a very good stand and a fine prospect for a good crop. We are almost through our corn the third time. Twice harvested and once cultivated, some of it twelve inches high. Will go through it two or three times yet. Our crop consists of 21 acres, as follows: 21 acres broom corn, 21 acres corn, 8 acres sweet and Irish potatoes, 2 acres millet, 2 acres beans, and 1 acre of peas. All that is up is looking fine. Our fruit prospects are good, strawberries and mulberries are now ripe, and a fair crop. Our cherries and early apples will be ripe in about two weeks. Peas and potatoes will be ready for the table in another week, and we will have a abundance of them. The health of our family is remarkably good. I don't think I have enjoyed better health in two years. My many friends in Webster County will be pleased to learn that her health is exceedingly good. Our church and Sunday-school are progressing nicely. Our day school began on the first Monday in May, and our children are all going regularly. With best wishes to all good night.
