## CURRENT COMMENT.

It was rumored in Berlin that Prince Bismarck will be asked to act as arbitrator in the Behring sea question.

Gov. RISSELL, of Massachusetts, has signed a bill preventing illegal marriages and divorces by Jewish rabbis.

Representatives of the people at Atlanta, Ga., presented at Pensacola, Fla., to the United States cruiser Atlanta, a magnificent silver service.

Two Paris jewelry firms have brought suit in attachment against federal officials at Chicago to obtain possession of smuggled diamonds obtained by fraud from the foreign dealers.

Judge GRESHAM declined the nomination of the citizens' committee for mayor of Chicago. It is understood the nomination was afterward tendered ex-Senator Farwell, who also refused to allow his name to be used.

It is reported that Justice Stephen, of England, whose mind is said to have been unshaken by the wretched incident to the trial of the Maybrick case, will soon be enabled to enjoy a prolonged vacation in the hope that the rest will be of benefit to him.

In the investigation of the sugar trust by the state senate committee G. L. Elliott, who had made a profit of over \$1,000,000. Stockholders had been paid 10 per cent. of this. The remainder was still in the hands of the constituent companies.

Col. CHARLES DREMOND, of the banking house of Messrs. Drummond, of London, committed suicide recently by shooting himself with a revolver. Troubles growing out of a lawsuit with his former friend was the cause of the act. The coroner's jury rendered a verdict of temporary insanity.

An important step has been taken in the settlement of the contest over the seat of Senator Dubois, of Idaho. His name has been put on the roll of senators and he will receive his pay as a duly elected United States senator from that state. Senator Edmunds says that the law and the precedents sustain this action.

Denver, Col., is without a mayor. The supreme court denied rehearing in the mayoralty case. The acting mayor, Wolfe Landauer, was a few weeks ago declared to be illegally elected after holding his office nearly a year. D. C. Packard, president of the board of supervisors, will probably act as mayor until after the city election next month.

At the sale of the Brayton Ives oriental art collection at New York, among the prominent people present were Mrs. W. K. Vanderbilt, Potter Palmer of Chicago, D. O. Mills, W. C. Whitney. The grand temple vase, both in form with elaborate color decorations painted in relief of the Yang Ching era, 2184 B.C., was sold to Potter Palmer for \$2,500.

Floods which followed the recent heavy snowstorm in Russia have destroyed one-half of the winter crops in many places in southwest Russia. The Volga has overflowed its banks and has inundated a great part of Warsaw. The inhabitants of that city are in distress owing to the floods, the severity of which can be judged from the fact that the ramparts which form a part of the fortifications have been in part destroyed by the rising waters.

The first application for repayment of the direct tax has been received by the treasury department on the 13th. It was from Governor Hill, of New York, and the amount of money called for was about \$2,225,000. The application must be scrutinized by the fifth auditor, the first complete report of the treasurer of internal revenue, the officer who made the original collections. When the account is verified a draft for the amount will be sent to the governor of New York, the money to be held in trust for distribution to the persons who paid the tax or their heirs.

The semi-official Novoe Vremya has taken up the line that if the Rothschilds expose the cause of the war, it means financial pressure upon the government and publishes a long, venomous article stating that the Rothschilds themselves have given the money to the Russian government, inasmuch that they now are practically all the maphtha springs of Baku and have arranged with the American Standard Oil Co. to divide the markets of the world. The Novoe Vremya then says that Russia is in a state of financial troubles, to give a Roland for an Oliver.

More than 100 days ago Capt. Norton sailed from New York for Europe on a small steamer of the same name, for which he claimed the quality of being unshakable. He has never been seen since. Now, one of the members of his company has heard from the ill-fated craft through a French newspaper, which declares that Capt. Norton died of starvation when eighty days out from port, a few days previously his wife and his niece, who accompanied him, having died. The steamer was driven by the wind and was driven far to the southward with the loss of its smokestack and deck house. At present the wreck lies about 3,000 miles east of the only survivor.

One of the curious incidents of the recent storm in England was the snowing up near Exeter of one of the old-fashioned four-horse coaches which still do duty in many parts of England in default of more modern methods of transit. The unfortunate passengers were compelled to camp by the roadside near the snowbank. They built a large fire, improvised a table and made of branches torn from trees bordering on the highway, and kept up their spirits as best they could. In spite of their efforts to make the best of a bad job, the almost entire lack of food among the party soon reduced them to a state of semi-starvation. When rescued the party was badly frozen and in a state of complete exhaustion.

Accounts have been appointed to allot lands in severity to the Sac and Fox and Iowa Indians and are on their way to the Indian Territory. Similar action will be taken as soon as possible by the War Department. The Indians have been told that they must be within which to take their territory, and if not taken, the agent is to make the allotment for them. These must be approved by the secretary of the Interior. The lands are to be open to settlement. The Iowa and Sac and Fox Indians are to be taken in severity under similar restrictions as to settlement. The Cheyenne and Arapaho have been told to take their lands in severity with the privilege of thirty days' extension.

## PERSONAL AND POLITICAL.

A LONG dispatch from Lord Salisbury on the Behring sea question was published on the 10th. The offer of arbitration was renewed.

CONGRESSMAN BRECKINRIDGE, of Kentucky, is reported quite sick at Pensacola, Fla.

The California senate has passed the bill drawn up by the attorney-general excluding the Chinese.

CAPT. N. E. MASON, of Troop E, Fourth cavalry, died at Vancouver, Wash., recently of Bright's disease.

SECRETARY BLAINE has received a cable message from Tokyo, Japan, announcing the death of United States Minister John F. Swift.

RUSSIAN SPECIAL AGENTS have been received at the state department containing a decree by the Brazilian president declaring the ports of that country free and open to the imports from the United States.

The Paris Temps says that the negotiations between France and England on the Newfoundland question have resulted in an agreement, which will be submitted to the French and English parliaments.

The prolonged contest over the United States senatorship in the Illinois legislature ended on the 11th in favor of the Democratic candidate, Cockrell and Moore finally deciding to cast their votes for him. The election was estimated to have cost the state \$100,000.

WHITELAW REID, United States minister to France, has written an introduction to an English edition of Tallyrand's memoirs.

CHIEF JUSTICE DUFFEL, of the Rhode Island supreme court, has resigned.

The German Reichstag has rejected the petition to admit women to the liberal professions.

The anti-Pinkerton bill has passed the lower house of the New York assembly by a vote of 98 to 12.

A WASHINGTON special says that the names of ex-Congressman Morrow and ex-Senator Ingalls are mentioned in connection with a successor to Minister Swift, who died at his post in Japan.

A PRIVATE telegram received in Hamburg from Chicago announced the assassination of President Balmaceda.

The Wisconsin assembly session was recently taken up with the civil rights bill, which puts the black man on an equality with white men. An amendment was adopted providing for the bill to land and water traffic accommodations, proposed by the democrats of the judiciary committee, was agreed to.

GEN. JOHN W. FILLER died recently at Toledo, O. He distinguished himself by defeating the rebels in Tennessee in 1862 and again at the battle of Corinth.

It is denied that the junketing congressmen attending Senator Hearst's remains to California acted unbecomingly.

PARKER went on another of his mysterious disappearances. He was supposed to be with Mrs. O'Shea. His friends were greatly disconcerted.

MISS MARY FLETCHER, of North Dakota, was recently nominated for lieutenant-governor of Rhode Island.

PRESIDENT HARRISON and party returned to Washington on the 13th. No ducks were killed during the day.

THE YOUNGEST daughter of ex-Secretary Bayard, is engaged to Count Lovenhaupt, of Sweden.

A COMPANY headed by W. J. Murphy, of Grand Forks, N. D., has purchased the Minneapolis Tribune from Alden J. Blodgett for \$400,000. It is stated that the Tribune will be sold to the publisher, who will take the editorial management.

KING C. LAMAR and Miss Louise Connelly were drowned while rowing in the canal, two miles above Augusta, Ga. Lamar was a graduate of Princeton university and a well known athlete. Miss Connelly was the daughter of the late John P. King, ex-United States senator from Georgia, and a niece of the marquisess of Anglesea.

DUNLAP HALL & Co., for years leading importers of Boston, have assigned with \$300,000 liabilities and ample assets. The senior partner had indorsed too much paper for personal friends.

JOHN GLOVER and his wife were killed by a railroad train near Holly Oak, Del., the other night.

The starch house of sugar refinery of the Florida Citrus Sugar Co. burned last night. The loss was \$100,000, fully insured. One employe was fatally burned.

At Kilgore, near Cattletown, Ky., six men were shot at a merry making. Four of them were killed. There has been much drinking and the fight arose from a quarrel over the selection of partners for a dance.

The steamship Venezuela, which has arrived at New York from Caracas, reports that Charles LeRoux, now in New York in a lime case, has been condemned to suffer the death penalty for his crime.

The records at Washington show that twenty-four democratic postmasters still hold office.

DR. LEWIS WISNOR, the partitioning lawyer of the Catholic college at Prussia, died on the 14th. He was born January 17, 1812.

A MINOR GUNSWOLD, widely known as "The Fat Contributor," editor of Texas Siftings, died suddenly of apoplexy at Cheyenne Falls, Wis., on the 13th.

The French government has acceded to the recent request of the Chilean revolutionists who asked that the Chilean war ships just completed at London and destined for the service of President Balmaceda should not be allowed to depart.

The acquittal of the Italians in New Orleans, charged with the murder of Police Chief Hennessy, was followed by the lynching. An infuriated mob took eleven of the accused and shot nine and hanged two. As might have been expected the lawlessness provoked great indignation among Italian residents in the country. Remonstrances being made to the secretary of state, causing Mr. Blaine to send a reproof to Gov. Nicholls.

The Hogan block and adjacent buildings at Syracuse, N. Y., were ravaged by flames on the 14th. The loss was about \$1,500,000. One man lost his life, and his own foothold.

The United States steamship Galena and the tug Mercury were wrecked at Gay Head, near Newport, R. I., recently.

CLARENCE HOWE returns for the week ended March 14 showed an average decrease of 12.5 compared with the corresponding week of last year. In New York the decrease was 18.5.

On the London stock exchange during the week ended March 14 confidence was gradually being restored. A better feeling was also noticed in Paris, where business had been considerably disturbed. The Berlin bourse was quiet.

The British commander of the Chilean government troops, was killed in the defeat of March 9.

The English and American committees have agreed upon a scheme of funding the Chilean bonds. The bonds are to be issued in exchange and deposited with a board of arbitration, who are to supervise the division of the new bonds among the various classes of holders.
