This legislature will in an optimistic mood the other day and proposed to reduce the rates charged by the newspaper of the state for printing the governor's proclamations, endorsing the constitutional amendments, after the appropriation bill had passed the committee. The house must have some short-sighted gentlemen within its confines. Suppose the newspapers in some of the counties after having been robbed in this way of their earnings, the rates having been established by law, should decline to print the messages? The consequence would be that no amendment could be constitutionally adopted. The constitution requires that amendments shall be printed for three months at least once each week in a newspaper in every county that has a newspaper. Consequently the co-operation of the press is absolutely necessary to the adoption of a constitutional amendment.

Now there may be some manhood left in the press and it is found that the legislature does not feel it would be profitable to pay legal rates for such advertisements. The press may conclude to decline the job. Such things have occasionally happened in the history of trade unions and labor combinations.—State Journal.

Children Cry for Pitcher's Castoria. He Disappeared in Omaha. GENE ROE, Neb., March 28.—(Special to The Bee.)—This community is greatly stirred up about the mysterious disappearance of Leland Parker, assistant postmaster at this place. He was a young man of more than ordinary intelligence and was exceedingly popular. About six months ago he left home to finish his education at Burlington, Ia., where close application to his studies caused his health to break down and he was compelled to return home about four weeks ago. This greatly worried him, as he was very ambitious and wanted to finish his education. He brooded over the matter and came to the conclusion that he was a mental failure, and although he had the kindest care from loving parents it seems that he could not endure the idea of his disappointed hopes. His father tried to induce him to consent to a tailor's treatment from one eminent specialist in mental troubles, but for a long time he resisted the idea as useless. Sunday March 13, he disappeared and told his father he had concluded to go to Omaha at once and consult a physician there. His father urged him to wait until next morning and he would go with him, but he was reluctantly allowed to go alone. He went to Omaha, consulted the physician and told him he was going to return home at once. Since then no trace of him has been discovered, although every effort has been made to find him.
