The Eight Hour Law
Below will be found the provisions of the new 8-hour law. While the farmers in the Legislature were willing to compel everybody else to require only 8 hours work of their employers for a day's work they made an exception in their own cases, and the farm hand can continue to put in the usual number of hours; also the hired girl.
SECTION 1. That eight hours shall constitute a legal day's work for all classes of mechanics, servants and laborers through the state of Nebraska, except those engaged in farm or domestic labor.
SECTION 2. Any employer or officers, agent or agents of the state of Nebraska or any municipality therein who shall openly violate or otherwise evade the provisions of this act, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor in office, and shall be suspended by the governor or the head of the department to which such officer is attached.
SECTION 3. Any employer or corporation working their employees over the time specified in this act shall pay an extra compensation double the amount per hour as paid for previous hours.
SECTION 4. Any parties contracting with the state of Nebraska, or any such corporation or private employers who shall fail to comply with or secretly evade the provisions thereof, be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and be punished by a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) nor more than one thousand dollars, and all acts or parties of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
