It is necesary that the school board of each listrict take into consideration the eeds of the school under their care and to employ a teacher suited to do their work for their particular d strict. plow. Some districts need teachers who have had cansiderable experience in teaching, and who have excellent qualifications in respect to the scholarship.

One who has never taught and de sires to teach will be obliged to commence somewhere. It is necessary that those who have not taught will find schools suited to their ability.

If we would have a sufficient number of experienced teachers and those well qualified to teach to supply the schools of our county, some of the districts will be obliged to pay better salaries.

We have some districts that pay their teachers well, and we have some that begrudge even a small salary to tricts were willing to pay more than ted States. that amount a month to teachers worth more than that, there would be to come to our county from other counties and help along in the educational work of the county. We have some experienced teachers, living in our own county, who do excellent work and are willing to improve professionally.

A forty dollar teacher should be paid forty dollars a month, A thirty dollar teacher should be paid thirty dollars a month. A person who is not worth thirty dollars a month in a schoolroom should not be employed at any price.

It is much better to have three months school taught in any district by a teacher worth fifty dollars a month than to have nipe months shool taught by a teacher worth twenty-five dollars a month.


