The following clipping from the Milwaukee Sentinel not only calls attention to a matter of national interest and importance, the preservation of the forests, but gives an indication of the influence exerted by one of the Nebraska senators and his unflinching industry in caring for all of the important affairs entrusted in his care: The executive committee of the American forestry association is doing valuable work in distributing Senator Paddock's report on the "bill to provide for the establishment, protection and administration of public reservations, and for administration of public forest reservations, and for other purposes," together with copies of the bill itself. Until now the country has had no forest policy. If we are ever to have one we must adopt it soon. The government, according to Senator Paddock's report, now retains rather less than 70,000,000 acres of timber or woodland as part of the public domain, mostly on the slopes and crests of western mountain ranges. This woodland is not properly administered at present and the timber on it can not be used with safety to the future condition of forest growth. These forest are needed to protect the sources of our great rivers, and their destruction would alter the climatic and meteorological conditions of the country. The proposed law, which was reported favorably to the senate in July of this year, provides for a survey of all forest lands to find out their location and extent, and authorizes the president to prohibit the sale of lands suited for forest reservations. The lands thus reserved will be in charge of the department of agriculture, to which the forestry bureau belongs. There seems to be every reason in favor of the passage of such a bill at the next session of congress. If something to protect our forests is not done soon it cannot be done at all.
