Proof of the Pudding.

Mulhall, the English statistician, recognized as the highest living authority in his specialty, gives the total manufacturers of the world in 1888 at \$22,370,000,000 or 32 1/2 billions. Of this amount the following were the figures of the leading nations: Austria.....\$1,205,000,000 France.....2,225,000,000 Germany.....2,315,000,000 Great Britain.....4,100,000,000 Italy.....1,815,000,000 United States.....7,215,000,000

Until recently England was the greatest manufacturing country in the world, but under free trade it has taken second place, while under protection the United States has advanced to the front rank, and now manufactures 65 per cent more than Great Britain.

The Independent Order of Odd Fellows is a secret society of American origin. The first lodge was founded in Baltimore, April 26, 1819, and it was known as Washington lodge No. 1. The growth of the order since its start has been remarkable. From 1830 to 1892, 2,000,000 members were initiated. It has spread from the United States and Canada, until now there is a flourishing membership in Australia, India and Germany. In this country there are at present 750,000 members, divided in 12,000 lodges and encampments.

The article by Lady Jeune contributed to the North American Review on "London Society," attracted extraordinary interest, especially in England, due, beyond doubt, to the intimate knowledge which she had of her subject.
