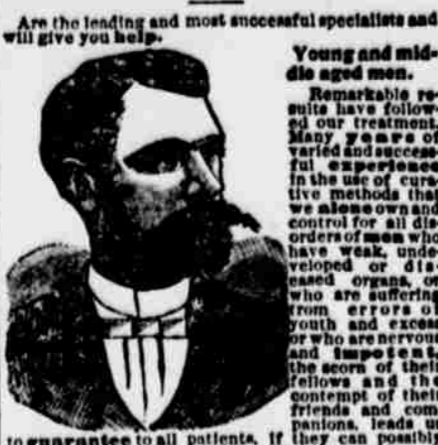

EDUCATIONAL NEWS

HAPPENINGS IN OUR SCHOOLS.

Furnished by County Superintendent D. M. Hunter.--A Communication from the University of Nebraska.

(Continued from last week.)

15--The board shall elect the principal and other teachers.

16--To secure uniformity, the state superintendent of public instruction, the president of the State Normal school and the chancellor of the State University shall constitute a high school board (to serve without remuneration). This board shall provide three courses of instruction for the county high school, each requiring three years for completion, namely: A General course, a College course, and Collegiate course.

The general course shall be designed for those who intend to become teachers, and shall fully prepare any who wish to enter upon professional work at the Normal School. The collegiate course shall fully prepare those who are to enter the first year of the University, or any other institution of higher learning in the state.

As far as practicable, students in these courses shall recite in the same classes. Students in the last year of the normal course may be employed for a portion of their time in teaching the pupils of the first year in any course. Model schools shall be encouraged.

17--Those graduating from the Normal course in the county high school shall be entitled to a teacher's first grade certificate, and shall be admitted to the professional work of the State Normal School without further examination. Those graduating from the Collegiate course shall be entitled to enter the State University without further examination.

18--Tuition shall be free to all pupils residing in the county where the school is located (except the pupils of such cities as may be exempt). No person shall be admitted to the county high school who shall not have passed a satisfactory examination in all the work of the district schools of the county in which such high school is situated; that is to say in at least practical arithmetic, English grammar, descriptive and physical geography, and the history of the United States.

19--If the school can accommodate more pupils than apply for admission from the county, vacancies may be filled by applicants from other counties or from cities exempt in the county, upon the payment of the proper tuition fees.

20--The general control and discipline of the school shall be in the hands of the principal.

21--The Board of Trustees shall report annually all details to the county superintendent. The report must be printed in at least one newspaper of the county, and a copy sent to the state superintendent.

22--The county commissioners shall have power to fill vacancies that may occur in the board of trustees, by appointment until the next general election.

23--The county commissioners shall allow each member of the board of trustees two dollars a day for the time actually employed in the discharge of his official duties. The trustees shall not be entitled to any further remuneration whatever, and the remuneration of any one trustee shall not exceed thirty dollars a year.

A COMMENT.

State Superintendent Gaines, of Kansas, in a recent letter writes as follows on the high school question: "In reply to yours of the 16 ult., asking my opinion as to the feasibility of establishing a county high school in your county, will say that I am a very warm supporter of the county high school system; however will not allow myself to overdraw the benefits to be derived from such an institution. I was connected with the first county high school established in the state for two years as an instructor, and had an opportunity to observe its workings in every detail. When the proposition carried in Dickinson county, it was thought by the opposers of the school that the institution would be a failure, and even the warmest advocates were to some extent embarrassed for fear that it would not prove a success. However, sufficient courage was mustered up and the building, costing about \$12,000 was erected. The school opened with an enrollment

of nearly 100, and before the close of the first year nearly 140 was reached. Since that time the enrollment has reached more than 160 per annum.

Of the number who attend the Dickinson county high school I will say that perhaps 80 per cent are young men and women who would never have attended an institution of learning other than the common district school had it not been that a free school of higher learning was established in their midst. Of this 80 per cent a large number from year to year will complete the three years course of study, and of those who complete the course many will continue their training in some higher institution of learning in the state.
