When the eastward drifting lows are on the crest of the Rockies they cause the winds on and around the Gulf of Mexico to change their prevailing course and, with increased velocity, they blow toward the northwestery low.

When the moisture is deficient in the rivers, soil and vegetation of this district the wind seeks a high elevation and therefore does not supply the necessary under or ground currents that furnish moisture for the lows and the only moisture they receive is from the weak and slow currents that go over the first or southeastern district.


