## WEATHER FORECASTS.

Furnished Expressly for The **Red Cloud Chief.**

(Copyrighted, 1896, by W. T. Foster.)  
ST. JOSEPH, Mo., Feb. 8.—My last bulletin gave forecasts of the storm waves to cross the continent from 12th to 16th and the next will reach the Pacific coast about 16th, cross the west of Rockies country by, close of 17th, great central valleys 18th to 20th and eastern states 21st.

This storm will bring the cold wave of February and cold weather equal to or below that about the 4th of February and 23d of January.

From 8th to 19th inclusive February will average warmer than usual, the warmest part of the month being 8th to 14th inclusive, and from 19th to March 4th will average colder than usual.

Rainfall will be generally deficient from 7th to 16th of this month and in many places excessive from 17th to March 6th. The most severe storms of the month will occur from 14th to 20th.

The warm wave will cross the west of Rockies country about 16th, great central valleys 18th, eastern states 20th. Cold wave will cross the west of Rockies country about 19th, great central valleys 21st, eastern states 23d.

The cold wave following the previous storm will be quite severe in the eastern states about 16th.

**ARIDITY AND IRRIGATION.**  
In the last bulletin I discussed crop weather of the southern states that constitute one of the four weather divisions of the summer season and now we will move with the prevailing winds to the countries about the west end of the Gulf of Mexico.

A peculiar weather condition prevails over this section east of the Rocky range and including Mexico, Indian Territory, southeastern Kansas and the eastern parts of Colorado and New Mexico.

In this weather district the prevailing winds, during the summer season, blow nearly west in Mexico, north in Texas and northeast in the Indian Territory returning to the Atlantic Ocean not far from New York. This is a part of the same circular motion of the atmosphere described as belonging to the first district and covering the southeastern states.


The prevailing winds are broken up in this second weather district by the highs and lows that move southeastward from the Pacific coast and also by the tropical storms, some of which are termed sub-tropical to distinguish them from the regular West India hurricanes.

The northern lows that move from west to east across the United States carry and condense the moisture that waters all the interior of the continent, including the supply of water for the great lakes.

When the eastward drifting lows are on the crest of the Rockies they cause the winds on and around the Gulf of Mexico to change their prevailing course and, with increased velocity, they blow toward the north-western low.

When the moisture is deficient in the rivers, soil and vegetation of this district the wind seeks a high elevation and therefore does not supply the necessary under or ground currents that furnish moisture for the lows and the only moisture they receive is from the weak and slow currents that go over the first or southeastern district.

the dry condition of the arid districts. The moisture laden air moves in such elevated streams that all the Missouri river countries suffer from drought when the north Atlantic high is unusually high and when it is unusually low these conditions cause droughts.

The gateway for the incoming moisture that must water nearly the whole of the United States, Canada and Mexico east of the Rocky range lies across the Gulf coast of Texas, or between the mouths of the Mississippi and the Rio Grande.

This moisture laden aerial river enters that gateway in good condition but immediately on reaching land a barrier is met, a condition that sends this aerial flow to a great elevation and thenceforth it is perverted and often fails to carry out the purpose for which the laws of nature designed it.

This great arid country 400 to 600 miles in width and extending northwestward more than 1000 miles constitutes the pathway of the most important water course in the world, an aerial river trying to perform its duties but prevented by the aridity of its pathway.

The heated condition and drying effects of this arid country causes the atmosphere carrying the moisture to rise to such great heights that it cannot enter the lower part of the storm center, therefore it adds to the top of the rising center of the low, causing the suction at the bottom to be greatly increased, while the moist, hot air from the Gulf is carried higher and goes to the high barometer then north-west or northeast of the storm center. This causes the descending air in the high to be excessively saturated with moisture, and floods result where rainfall is not needed.

The hot, moist air spoken of above that comes from the Gulf and strikes the low, or storm center at great elevation is one of the common causes of tornadoes.

I have thus shortly sketched the elements of droughts and floods and their remedies in two of the four crop weather districts of this continent. One special feature relates to all. For relief from droughts and floods the people of each of these four districts must learn that they are interdependent. The local conditions in each of the four districts affect each of the other three districts.

The American people readily understand that to retain or regain their freedom from the encroachments of foreign countries they must stand united. They must also be taught that to retain and retain fertility for all our lands all the people of all North America must unite in one common cause against droughts and floods.
