WASHINGTON NOTES

One who tries to ascertain the true status of the political situation by comparing what is given out at the Bryan headquarters with what is given out at the McKinley headquarters is apt to think with the oft-quoted man who exclaimed "All men are liars!" It is a part of the game of politics to claim everything, in order to induce those who are on the fence to get down on your side. But the private utterances of the politicians are often directly opposite to what they say for publication, and as a rule they represent pretty nearly their real opinion. From their public talk, you would suppose that the gold men and the silver men are equally confident, but their conversation in private tells a different story. The past week has made heavy inroads upon the stock of confidence at Bryan headquarters, and has largely increased that article at McKinley headquarters. It has become plain to the most enthusiastic silverite that Bryan need expect nothing from the east, and the Indianapolis ticket may throw some of the southern states for McKinley. Bryan's managers are also being hampered by a lack of money to carry on the campaign which they have mapped out, while the McKinley managers are flooding the doubtful states with literature and filling them with stump speakers. And to add to it—500 counties, the complaints against the 500 in which the Bryan managers are sending things, are interesting.

Senator Butler, chairman of the national committee, will not talk about the conference he had with Jim Watson several days ago, in which he said that Watson is a knave, and that he thinks the only way to get the would-be greatly hampered by the withdrawal of Sewall. Mr. Sewall has added to the difficulties of the situation by his positive statement that he doesn't intend to withdraw, which is thought to be intended as a hard slap at those who were scheming to get him off the ticket.

While everybody wishes to see the peace of the country brought about by the highest possible offices, there are many who believe that making the employees' spies upon each other will help things along to the point where they are. However, among the few who do believe in the spy system are the post office department officials, who have issued a circular to the railroads, service clerks, calling their attention to the general order issued last winter, requiring employees to report instances of irregularity and misconduct of any employees which come to their knowledge to the clerks of division or to be forwarded to Washington, and warning them of punishment to come if they do not obey those orders. Remembering the scorn with which school children treated the "traitor" of the school, and that men are but grown-up school children, it is not surprising that this order has been quietly ignored in the past, nor will it be surprising if it continues to be ignored, notwithstanding these threats.

While I do not expect that he will do so, nobody need be surprised if Secretary Campbell should go to Kentucky and take the stump for Pittman and Buckner. It is a known fact that he has been very active in the things which he has done in other states, and that he has made of his management of the railway and of his record in the case of the McKinley case, a very good record. It is possible that he will be able to get 25,000 votes in Kentucky. If they could get that number, McKinley would be able to carry the state. Secretary Campbell has a strong personal following in Kentucky, and the Bryan managers would do well to try to see that they take the stump in that state. The fact is that the Indianapolis ticket is expected to get votes enough to be a factor in the result are Kentucky, Illinois and Indiana. In many of the other states, however, it is not so.

Senator Hill is being very carefully watched by both silver democrats and gold democrats. Both sides are intimating that he will shortly come out for their ticket, but it is easy to see that neither side knows just where Hill stands. His actions and words at the Chicago convention would seem to make it very easy for him to come out against Bryan and for the Indianapolis ticket. On the other hand, many believe that when he entertained Mr. Bryan at his New York home he made a bargain to come out for Bryan at the coming democratic state convention. It is altogether probable that Senator Hill, who is nothing if not a shrewd politician, will be largely governed by the local conditions in New York in choosing the position he will occupy, although there are reports which say that the local conditions, manipulated by Hill's democratic opponents, are forcing him into a position willy nilly.
