FIRST OF HOOFED ANIMALS. Supposed to Have Lived on Western Prai-

ries 500,000 Years Ago. In the rooms of Prof. E. D. Cope, at Philadelphia, the person fortunate enough to gain admission, says the St. Louis Republic, may see the creature which all naturalists are unanimous in pronouncing the first representative of the hoofed-animal species. 


