

that a similar undertaking is contemplated in Egypt. The general inspector of public works, Mr. Prompt, has just submitted to the Egyptian government the results of his investigations during the last eight months relative to the utilization of the cataracts of the Nile for agricultural and mechanical pur-His project includes an immease reservoir in upper Egypt which will permit the culture of cane sugar and cotton in the place of cereals. In the furtherance of the realization of this project he proposes to establish an electric power station near Assuan. where a fail of forty-five feet will be utilized. This station would furnish 40,000 horse power, besides furnishing 500,000,000 cubic yards of water for irrigation. A fifteen-foot dam is to be built across the Nile just above Cairo, which would furnish both light and motive power at a very low price to the Egyptian capital. The cost of the entire project is estimated at \$8,000,000. which will very likely be raised by private subscription.


