STEPS IN BEEKEEPING.

How to Avoid the Rocks on Which Beginners Usually Split. The first step is to get a good text book on bee-keeping and study it thoroughly. Then get another one and study that. Perhaps a third could be profitably added to the list.

Spring is the best time to buy bees, and it is better to get them as near home as possible, as express charges are very heavy, and long journeys are likely to injure the colonies.

It might be well for the beginner to produce extracted honey at first, in which case an extractor would be needed. This costs about ten dollars, but no sections would be needed, nor so much foundations, though there would be needed some vessels in which to store the honey.

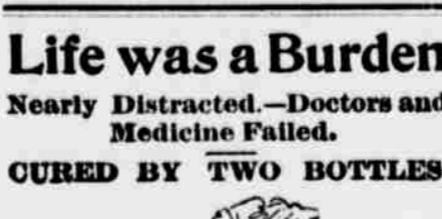
How to Protect Stocks Effectually from Rain and Snow. Where hay is stacked out of doors for several months, it will pay to secure



GOOD HAY CAP TO USE. Large sheets of old canvas and stretch over the stack, pinning the corners by driving a peg in the stack. The plan is a modification of the smaller hay cap used extensively in the field, during the hay harvest, when rainy weather suddenly comes on.
