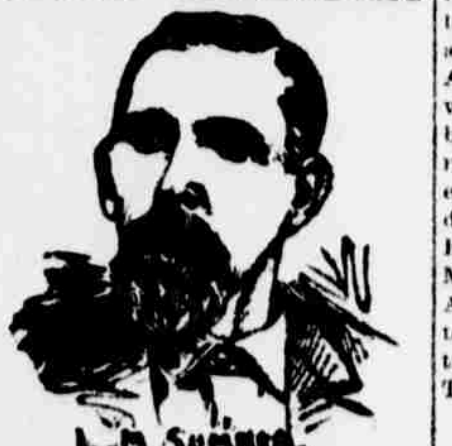
Left Home.

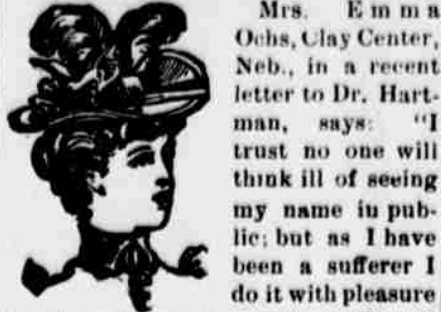
