**CANADA AS HIS EXEMPLAR.**

Hon. P. S. Crosscup, Federal Judge, Circuit Court, recently said in an address: "Canada is in every practical feature of independence as self-governed as if she acknowledged no allegiance to the British crown. It sends no representatives to the Parliament House on the Thames. Great Britain sends none to the Parliament House on the Ottawa. She pays no taxes into the British exchequer; she receives none from any people outside of her own boundaries. She is touched by no law relating to her trade, her development, or her liberty except such as comes from her own legislative assemblies. She exercises her own internal affairs stands sponsor for her own internal peace and social order. Her courts are made up of her own citizens, appointed by authority themselves of her own citizenship. In every square mile of her territory, she is absolutely self-governed people. The British flag is in flag only by choice, the British crown her sovereign only in name."
