A Bill for a Joint Resolution recommending o the electers of the state to vote at the next election of members of the Legislature for or against a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebras ks in accordance with Section 2, Article 15, of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, Re it Resolved by the Legislature of the State o.

1. That it is deemed necessary to call a convention to revise, amend and change the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

2. That the electors are recommended to vote February fees 141.00 lature for or against a convention to revise. amend and change the Constitution of the State


