The past week has been wet, temperature about normal. The average daily temperature departure has been less than 1 degree in most parts of the state. The maximum temperature of the week were generally about 90 degrees.

The rainfall of the week has been normal or above in most sections. It has been deficient, however, in the extreme southeastern corner and in parts of the western portion of the state.

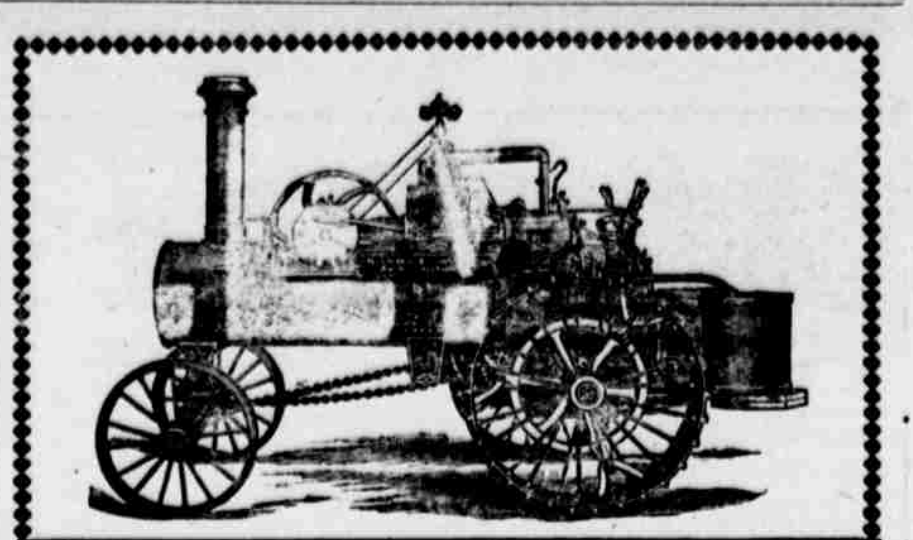

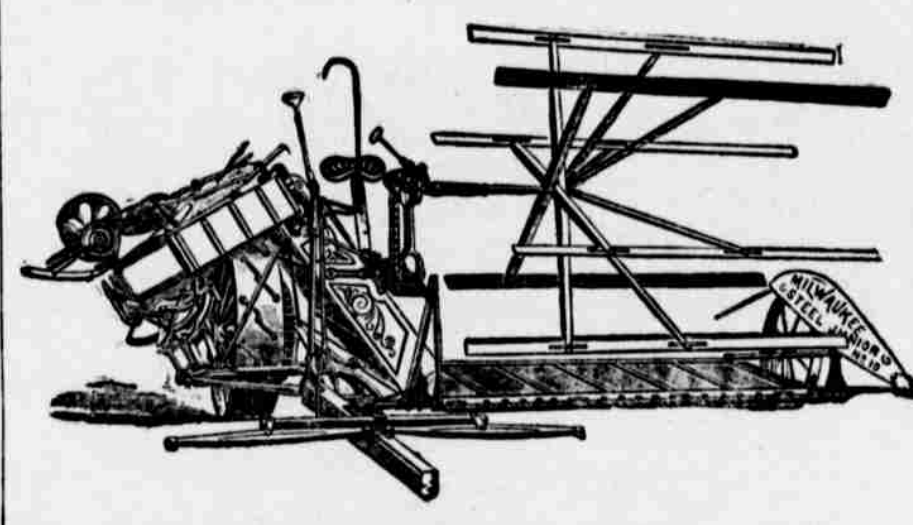
