Special Election For New Court House

The Board of County Commissioners have called a special election for April 14th for the purpose of settling the county court house matter. Their proposition is to carry out the plans already agreed upon by the latter. In as much as the new law has been declared invalid by the supreme court some other means must be found for furnishing the funds for this purpose. In effect this election is for the purpose of going ahead with the building just as tho the other law was valid. In this case the voters of the county will say whether they are willing to vote instead of by petition. No more money will be raised than usual, simply a portion of the funds diverted to the building fund. The levy is not to exceed fifteen mills for all purposes.

There is ample evidence that the board has acted in absolute good faith in this matter and this ought to quiet any street talk to the contrary. The Chief believes that this contemplated structure is large enough for all county purposes and that Webster county does not need a one hundred or a two hundred thousand dollar building.
