PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. THREE.

The following proposed amendment to the constitution of the State of Nebraska, as hereinafter set forth in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 3rd, 1914. FOR A JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT... Sec. 1. That at the general election for state and legislative officers to be held on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November, 1914, the following be submitted as amendments to Sections 1 and 2 of Article V, of the Constitution of Nebraska...

Hunter, filed his petition herein in the district court of Webster County, Nebraska on the 7th day of July 1914, against the defendants Christian Hansen and Amanda V. Hansen, the object and prayer of which is to foreclose a certain mortgage, executed by the defendants Christian Hansen and Amanda V. Hansen, to the plaintiff herein, upon the south half of the south west quarter (S. 1/2 SW. 1/4) and the north east quarter of the south east quarter (N. E. 1/4 SE. 1/4) and the south half of the south east quarter (S. 1/2 SE. 1/4) all in town one (1), section thirty three (33), range nine (9), West 6 P. M., Webster county, Nebraska, to secure payment of a certain note, dated June 14th, 1910, for the sum of \$950.00 due and payable in five years from date thereof, and on which default has been made in the payment of the interest due in June 1914; and as is provided in the terms of said mortgage, plaintiff has elected to declare the whole amount due on said note and mortgage; that the amount due and unpaid on said note and mortgage is \$1148.00, for which sum with interest at 8 per cent from July 7, 1914, plaintiff prays for a decree that defendants be required to pay the same, or that said premises be sold to satisfy the amount found due.
