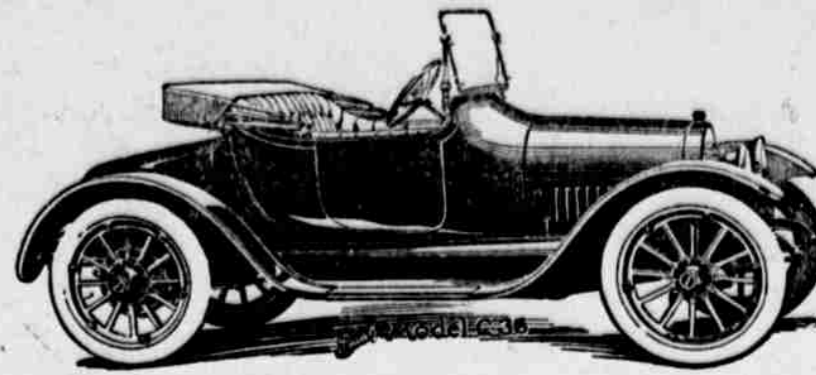

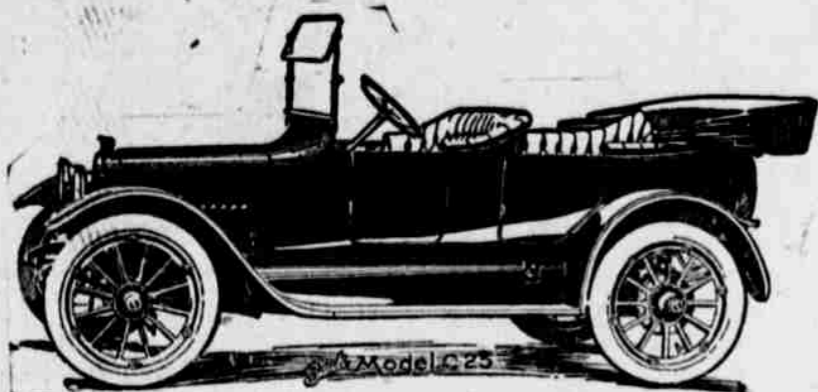

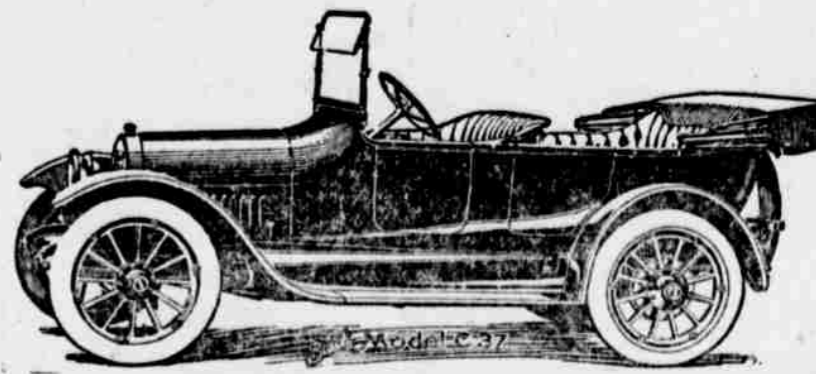

The Pig Club is the latest addition to the list of Boys' and Girls' Clubs open for membership to the young people of the state. Membership rules will be much the same as for the corn and tomato clubs. The list of prizes that are expected to be offered—like the rules—have not been prepared. The leader in charge of the new club is J. G. McMillan. He is a graduate of the Iowa State Agricultural College, and has been teaching agriculture in the high school at Holdrege. During the fall and winter he will appear on the program of a number of farmers' institutes and short courses to explain the nature of the work. The Pig Club the same as all the Boys' and Girls' Clubs, is carried on co-operatively by the United States Department of Agriculture and the Nebraska College of Agriculture. Information concerning the club may be obtained from the Agricultural Extension Service, University Farm, Lincoln.
