Sunday Schools started, 264: teachers appointed, 876; scholars enrolled, 7,837; brought into existing schools, 1,114; total gathered into schools, 9,849; schools visited and atded, 2,690; homes visited, 45,018; addresses and sermons delivered, 3,452; bibles and testaments distributed, 4,177; Christian literature circulated, \$3 409.86; preaching stations opened, 43; Young People's Societies organized, 26; hopeful conversions reported, 1,111; denominational churches developed, 13; home departments organized, 42.
