Mrs. David Cartwright

Elietta Shute, daughter of Thomas F. and Mary Shute, was born April 6, 1853, in New Hampshire and died at Lincoln, Nebraska, September 14, 1915, aged 62 years, 5 months and 8 days. With her parents she moved to Nebraska, in early childhood, and in 1873 came to Jewell county, Kansas, where she had since resided.

She was united in marriage to David H. Cartwright, April 14th, 1880, and to this union were born fifteen children, all of whom, except one, Gracie, who died November 25, 1893, survive her.

Mrs. Cartwright's health had been failing for some time. A few weeks ago her illness became serious and it became necessary to take her to the hospital at Lincoln. She was a true Christian and a church member since early childhood, being a charter member of the Highland M. E. church. Truly it is said of her she has lived a true Christian life. She was a kind wife, a fond loving mother and a good neighbor, always trying to do something for those around her.

Funeral services were held at the Highland church, Friday morning at 10 o'clock, conducted by the Highland minister, assisted by Rev. G. W. Hummel. Interment was made in the Highland cemetery.
