

To Get Fertile Eggs

Collect the flock rigidly for weak stock. Select on the basis of vigor, size, and production. Use only mature stock. Use males of the large, vigorous type, showing well-developed breast, strength of bone, good-sized comb and wattles, and bright eyes. Remember the male is half the flock. It is not necessary to buy new blood every year. A desirable male should be used for two or three years for best results. Allow stock free access to grass range, and feed sparingly.—Poultry Section, College of Agriculture.

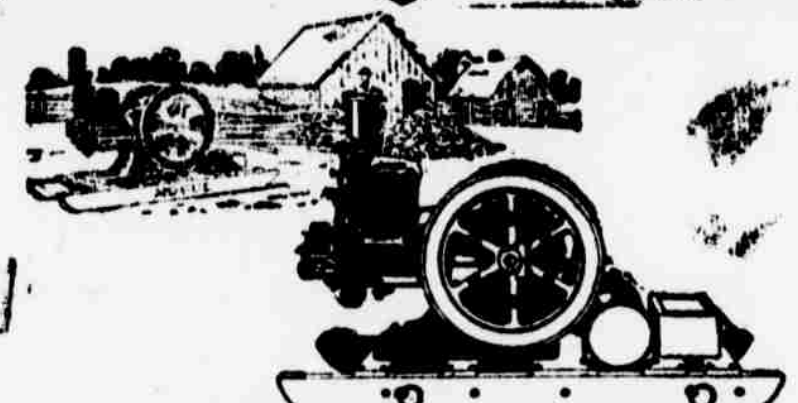
