An ordinance providing for the purchase of one 100 H. P. Fatrbanks Morse Semi-disse oil Engine direct connection to No. 75 K. V A. Fairbanks Morse 200 volt Alternator with Excitor and Installation equipment and doclaring the existance of an emergency for

the purchase of said engine. Be it enacted by the mayor and city coun, ell of the City of Red Cloud:

Section t.
