Beef Regulations

To all Hotels, Restaurants, Clubs and Public Eating Houses, Gentlemen: At the present time there is a shortage of beef, consequently the following beef regulations will go into effect Monday, June 17th. You will be permitted to serve roast beef one meal per week, beef steak one meal per week, boiled beef two meals per week. The following are the meals on which you should serve these products. Monday noon, roast beef; Tuesday evening beef steak; Wednesday noon, boiled beef; Saturday noon, boiled beef. The noon day meal begins at 11 o'clock and ends at 2:30 p. m. The evening meal begins at 5:30 and ends at 1:00 a. m.

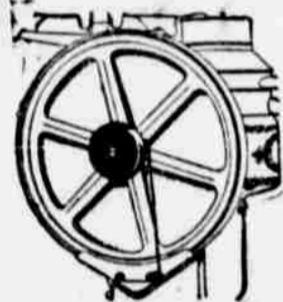
