War Tax In accordance with Article VI of the War Revenue Act of October 3, 1917, which provides that “The tax is to be paid by the persons paying the admission, and must be collected by the proprietor of every place to which admissions are charged,” the tax on single admission tickets will be paid at the gate at time of purchase. Holders of season tickets bought in advance will save time and inconvenience by paying the tax and having their tickets validated for admission at the gate. The cashier will be in attendance there for that purpose the afternoon of the day preceding and forenoon of the opening day of the Chautauqua. ALL TICKETS MUST BE VALIDATED and tax paid before they can be accepted for admission.
