It gives the impression that the season is far advanced. We involuntarily look at the calendar to see what time it is.

Press reports are to the effect that troops of the Central Powers are showing sullenness—that an anti-Prussian sentiment is developing within the ranks. These reports, which may be more or less true, are merely straws showing the direction of the wind and should not be taken as indicating an end of the war or the promotion of any peace propoganda.

Do you realize that there are nearly 1,400,000 American soldiers in France actually engaged in war duty? An American army is over there paying off the debt we owe France for sending Lafayette and his soldiers to our assistance some little time ago. They are doing more than pay off an old debt. They are aiding to make the world a safe place to live in. There are approximately 15,000,000 men signifying today that they will if need be go to the assistance of the 1400,000—over ten to one in reserve force. 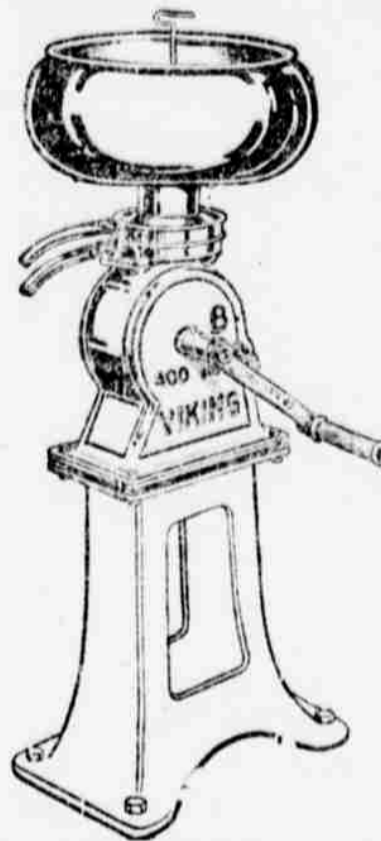

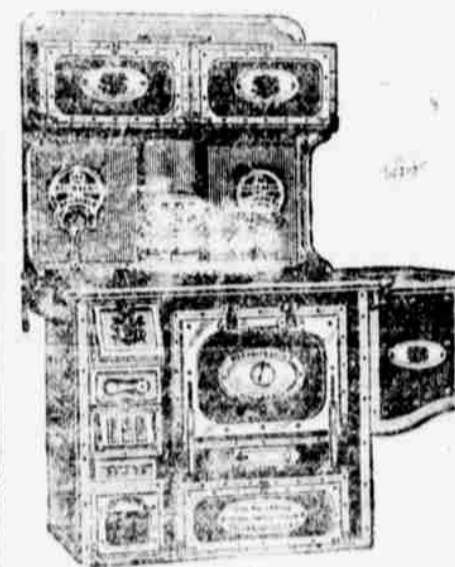
