Why An Over Subscription

To the United War Works Campaign Is Asked.

When the original budget of \$170,000 was endorsed as a basis for this campaign it was done with a vision that by November 1st our country would have an overseas force of about one million. However this date finds us with an American army abroad of over two million. A correspondingly larger number are in our training camps.

When the budget was made up it carried no appropriation for work among our own navy afloat; today we have perhaps a larger number of men on the seas than the rest of the world combined.

When the budget was assembled we were but partially serving our ally, France. Since we are asked to cover her armies entire. We are also asked to put the same service into the Italian armies.

The funds accruing from the original appropriation would necessitate another appropriation for June or July. The other alternative, suggested by John H. Mott at the recent Chicago conference, which it was my fortune to attend, was not to increase the quota but over subscribe it by approximately fifty per cent. Mr. Mott's suggestion was unanimously chosen.

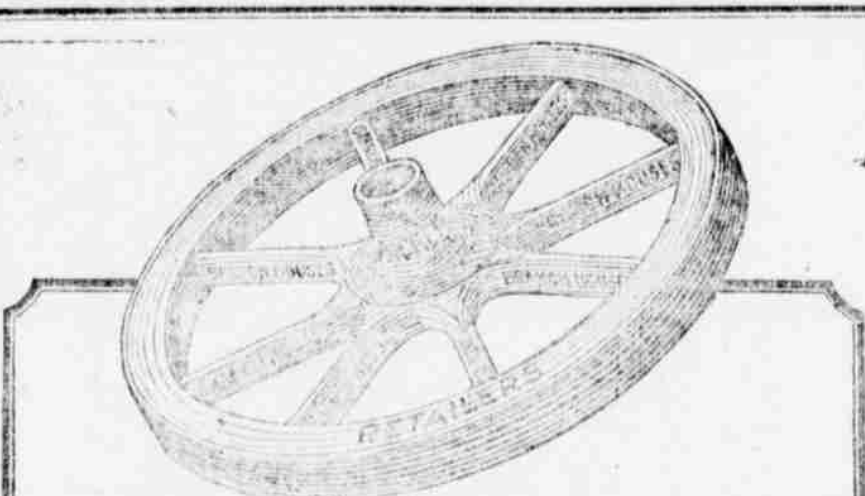

TELEPHONE SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGES AND MOVE CHARGES. By order of the Postmaster General of the United States the following schedule for service connection and move charges was made effective September 1st, 1918. Service Connection Charges—Where the rate is \$2.00 a month or less \$5.00. Where the rate is more than \$2 but not exceeding \$4 a mo. 10.00. Where the rate is more than \$4.00 a month 15.00.
