WHO MAY ATTEND Two boys will be admitted from each of the ninety-two countles. The age of the delegates must be over fifteen and under twenty-one.

APPLICATIONS All boys that would like to be a delegate must write their application or call at the County Agent's office on Saturday, and from the applicants two delegates will be se-

lected. Do this at once. WHAT EACH BOY SHALL FURNISH

Each boy will pay five dollars (\$5.00) to cover board, tuition and incidentals, which amount should be sent to the Secretary of the State Fair, Lincoln, Nebr., two weeks before opening of camp. Railroad fare will be refunded by the Board. Receipt from railroad agent must be presented for return of amount paid. Each boy must provide blankets, sheets, pillow, towels, soap, cup and saucer, plate, knife. fork and spoon, and may be required to perform from two to four hours duty each day during the afternoon or
